CONSECUTIVE INTERPRETING WITH TEXT - EXERCISE 3

It should be noted that alcohol was a factor in the offences before the court. **(pause)**

The subject advised that she began drinking around the age of 12. (pause)

She was also a frequent user of marijuana during her teens. (pause)

She indicated that she was not in any trouble as a youth and has no prior criminal record. (pause)

She was held in prison cells for intoxication "not even ten times" and was never charged. (pause)

She believes her drinking became a problem about a year ago.(pause)

In February/March of 2009 she was drinking daily in addition to smoking marijuana and snorting oxycodone pills. (pause)

She was having problems in her relationship at this time. (pause)

She advised that her drinking interfered with her work and that she went to work intoxicated on one occasion. **(pause)**

She received a warning letter from her supervisor. **(pause)** Apart from that, she does not believe her alcohol consumption has had any negative repercussions. **(pause)**

She indicated no negative repercussions as a result of drug abuse. (pause)

She guit using all substances in August after incurring a criminal charge. (pause)

The subject's partner, Mr. Sullivan, advised that "shit hits the fan" when the subject is drinking, especially when he is around. **(pause)**

He does not like being around her when she is drinking and will leave for a few days. (pause)

He often ends up drinking too. (pause)

His absence results in his partner thinking he is cheating on her, creating more problems. **(pause)**

Mr. Sullivan indicated that the subject has managed to stop drinking in the past during times when he has stopped as well. **(pause)**

The subject seems dependent on him to initiate such changes in behaviour. (pause)

He is prepared to support her through any Court ordered conditions, including requirements to abstain from alcohol or reside in an alcohol-free residence. **(pause)**

He indicated that she has been compliant with her current Undertaking conditions. (pause)
